Thanks to your meaningful support, Cancer Care Services is off to a great start this year. We are celebrating our 70th birthday and reaching new service milestones. We hope this quarterly report will provide an effective update on what Cancer Care Services is doing with your generous investment dollars. On the following page, you will find results of our first quarter in 2016. But first, let's recap the impact Cancer Care Services had in Tarrant, Hood and Parker County in 2015.

- We served over 4,600 cancer clients.
- A new attendance record was set for our CampCARE; a camp for children who are living with someone affected by cancer.
- We launched a brand new website.
- We secured \$2 million in pharmaceutical grants directly for cancer patients.
- We spent over \$1,415,000 in 2015 in direct financial assistance to local cancer clients.



In January, we broke a record with regard to client referrals. We received 31 referrals from our new website! We had the privilege to enroll 88 new cancer clients in January, 97 new clients in February and 98 clients in March!

Our clients are at 250% or below the federal poverty guidelines. By providing clients with direct financial assistance, (medication, insurance premiums, nutrition, transportation, supplies etc.) our clients are able to complete treatment, return to work, and function as normally as possible. **Our goals are bold: 1). Increase capacity to survive cancer. 2). Improve quality of life.**
